Dear Friends in Christ,

During the past week I participated in the monthly meeting of the Parish Pastoral Council. We did not meet in December so we had some catching up to do. Later this month I'll meet with the parish Finance Council to review the financial reports from July 1- December 31, 2022

In the days before everyone had calendars and smartphones, the Church developed a custom of announcing the date of Easter and moveable feasts, whose dates are calculated from the time of Easter, on or around the Epiphany. I reproduce here the announcement for 2023, courtesy of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops.

Know, dear brethren (brothers and sisters), that, as we have rejoiced at the Nativity of our Lord Jesus Christ, so by leave of God's mercy we announce to you also the joy of his Resurrection, who is our Savior.

On the twenty-second day of February will fall Ash Wednesday, and the beginning of the fast of the most sacred Lenten season.

On the ninth day of April you will celebrate with joy Easter Day, the Paschal feast of our Lord Jesus Christ.

On the twenty-first day of May will be the Ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ 1

On the twenty-eighth day of May, the feast of Pentecost.

On the eleventh day of June, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.

On the third day of December, the First Sunday of the Advent of our Lord Jesus Christ, to whom is honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen. Sincerely Yours, in Christ,

The **IRA Charitable Rollover** allows donors who are 70.5 years or older to transfer up to \$100,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. In doing so, donors keep their IRA distribution from impacting their gross income and possibly avoid being bumped into a higher tax bracket. The IRA charitable rollover can also count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD), which starts at age 72.

All transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation by December 15th to qualify as a 2022 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income.
