FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

During the past week, Fr. Tennant met with the parish finance council to review the financial statements from July 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021. The reports showed a stable financial condition, in which income slightly exceeds expenditures. This is partly due to reduced expenditures, since an unpaid seminarian intern is carrying out the supervision of the religious education program, which was previously the responsibility of a paid part-time employee. It is also due to offertory income being a bit higher than what was anticipated, even though attendance has dipped in comparison to pre-Covid times. As always, our community is grateful to the many parishioners who support it consistently and generously through their sacrificial giving.

Beginning this Sunday, the Gospel readings will be taken primarily from the Gospel according to St. Luke. Fr. Jerome H. Neyrey, S.J. of the University of Notre Dame explains:

"In Luke's story we often find incidents stitched together by a literary technique called "prophecy – fulfillment." Something predicted, either in the Old Testament or more recently by a prophet, is eventually fulfilled. This point of view underscores God's reliability in the events of salvation history."

This technique is certainly evident in this Sunday's Gospel reading, in which Jesus stands up in the synagogue in Nazareth and announces that the prophecy of Isaiah has now come to fulfillment. In every celebration of the Eucharist we experience the fulfillment of the Lord's promise to be with His people always. We put our trust in his faithfulness.
