FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! What a beautiful celebration of the 125th anniversary of the dedication of St. Mary's Church in Marion! Thank you to all who came out for it, including those from Sacred Hearts Parish.

Please remember to vote NO on Issue 1 on NO-vember 7th. This extreme amendment seeks to enshrine abortion in the Ohio Constitution. It endangers the health and safety of women, threatens parental rights, and allows for abortion through all nine months of pregnancy. It is especially critical to our understanding of the human person who is made in the image and likeness of God even at the earliest stages of life that we would not allow this to happen.

Also, please vote No on Issue 2, which seeks to legalize the use of recreational marijuana. It threatens public health: According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, "The **use of drugs** inflicts very grave damage on human health and life." (paragraph 2291). It endangers children because marijuana use by youth has risen considerably in states where recreational use has been legalized, harming child development, especially neurologically. It also endangers communities since studies show legalization of marijuana increases traffic accidents and fatalities, as well as increasing rates of workplace accidents and injuries.

It is good to be involved in our political system because our policies shape our society and affect the common good (see Catechism of the Catholic Church #2239). At the same time, we must form our consciences according to Church teaching.

May Mary, the mother of Jesus, conceived in her womb, protect the unborn and may Almighty God bless you and your families!
