FROM THE PASTOR

Merry Christmas! I want to thank you all for your wonderful cards, gifts, goodies, and treats that you have given these past few weeks for Advent and Christmas. I'm sure I speak as well for Fr. Keller and the office staff that we greatly appreciate all of you.

We have something exciting happening at Sacred Hearts parish in Cardington. December 27, 2023 is the anniversary of the first apparition of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in Paray-le-Monial, France 350 years ago. In commemoration of this 350-year anniversary, Pope Francis has declared December 27, 2023 through June 27, 2025, the date of the Solemnity of the Feast of the Sacred Heart, to be a Jubilee year. During the Jubilee Year, an indulgence can be obtained by making a pilgrimage to Paray-le-Monial, known as the City of the Eucharist. Bishop Earl Fernandes will lead a diocesan pilgrimage to France, including a visit to Paray-le-Monial, from May 31 to June 9, 2024 for the Jubilee.

For people who cannot make the diocesan pilgrimage, a plenary indulgence can be obtained locally. Four sites in the Columbus Diocese will be places of pilgrimage during the Sacred Heart Jubilee year: Cardington Sacred Hearts Church, Columbus Sacred Heart Church, Coshocton Sacred Heart Church and New Philadelphia Sacred Heart Church. Yes, that includes Sacred Hearts, Cardington parish!

The faithful can receive the plenary indulgence during the Jubilee Year after meeting the following conditions: visiting one of the local pilgrimage sites; assisting at Mass; reciting prayers, such as the Litany of the Sacred Heart; making a Holy Hour of reparation; and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father. To receive the plenary indulgence, the usual conditions – detachment from sin, Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion within a reasonable time period and prayer for the Holy Father's intentions – also must be met. An indulgence is a grace granted by the Catholic Church through the merits of Jesus Christ, the Blessed Virgin Mary and all the saints.

I am still seeking clarification if the plenary indulgence can be received just once for the entirety of the Jubilee Year, or if it can be received once per day throughout the Jubilee Year. The Diocese has had to call Rome!

By the time you read this, the Jubilee Year will have already started. Sacred Hearts, Cardington church doors will be unlocked from 8:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m., every day, 7 days a week, for the next year and a half. I hope the Jubilee Year will be a time of grace to deepen your devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. We thank God for this grace!

As we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph this weekend, may they bless your family now and always! And on January 1st, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Mother of God. It is not a Holy Day of Obligation this year, but we will have Mass at both parishes at 10:00 a.m. May Mary, the Mother of God, be your mother as well.
