"A Good and Growing Need" Collection. For the weekend of February 24/25, the diocese is asking all parishes to take up a second collection for the support of educating our seminarians. The tuition and room and board for each seminarian is \$55,000.00 per year, and this year, with the addition of 16 new seminarians, the Diocese needs the collection in order to fill the gap from the funding that normally comes from The Appeal (formerly The Bishop's Annual Appeal). The Appeal itself begins at the beginning of May, but this particular collection is a one-time collection. It is good that we have so many new seminarians because we need the priests, but of course, it is expensive to educate them. Any help is greatly appreciated.
