FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

By now I hope everyone is aware that this Wednesday is Ash Wednesday! We will celebrate two Masses with distribution of ashes, at 8:45 a.m. and at 6:00 p.m. On every Friday of Lent, we will pray Stations of the Cross together in the church, followed by an opportunity for confession. Ash Wednesday is a day of fasting and abstinence from meat. Every Friday of Lent is a day of abstinence from meat. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding from age 14 onwards.

While many people think about Lent as a season for "giving up" things, I'd like to encourage everyone to think of it as a time to "give more" to God and to the poor. This is the thinking behind the three traditional works of Lent: fasting, prayer, and almsgiving. Of course, in order to be able to "give more" to God, we have to "give up" devoting so much time, thought, and money to matters of lesser importance.

Speaking of time, it is amazing how quickly time seems to pass as one grows older. Recently I started making some calculations and realized that I was appointed pastor of this parish in July of 2016 – that will make six years this July! Does it seem that long to you? I give thanks to God for all the blessings this community has brought me in the last five and one half years.
