FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

In this Sunday's Gospel, three of the apostles climb a mountain with Jesus and see him momentarily transfigured. We always hear this Gospel during Lent, to prepare us for a darker scene, when Christ will climb Mt. Calvary, carrying his cross. The Transfiguration is reminiscent of a story from the Old Testament, from chapter thirty-three of the Book of Exodus. Moses climbs Mt. Sinai, to receive a revelation from God. He begs the LORD to reveal his face, but Moses sees only God's back. The Apostles, however, see the glory of God shining on the face of the Lord Jesus. With Christ, the perfect revelation of the Father's love and mercy has arrived, and the Father's voice is heard, "This is my beloved Son. Listen to him!"

Don't forget that we pray the Stations of the Cross in the church on the Fridays of Lent at 6:00 p.m., followed by an opportunity for confession. This is one way that we can answer Christ's call to pick up our cross, follow him, repent, and believe in the Good News.
