FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord, Jesus Christ! If you are reading this on Sunday, March 3rd, our parish is having our Adoration day from the end of the 9:00 a.m. Mass until 8:00 p.m. I invite you to come and do a "Holy Hour," spending time with the Lord before the Blessed Sacrament in church.

On Saturday, March 16th, at the 4:30 p.m. Mass, Bishop Fernandes is coming to publicly install me as the pastor of Sacred Hearts. It has been official since last July, but this is the first opportunity the Bishop has had to celebrate Mass at our parish. There will also be a reception dinner afterwards in Foeller Hall. All are invited to both.

We will have two Lenten talks given on Tuesday evenings after the 6:00 p.m. Mass. The first is this Tuesday, March 5th, given by Fr. Seth Keller, whose talk will be "Prayer: Living the Adventure of Life with God." The second is on March 12th, given by me, and the talk will be "Wielding the Power of the Cross: Using Your Suffering Against the Enemy." Both will be in Foeller Hall, beginning around 6:45 p.m. with light refreshments.

On Tuesday, March 19th, the Solemnity of St. Joseph, following the 6:00 p.m. Mass, we will have a parish penance service with possibly two additional priests to help hear Confessions. Please remember the Church precept that all Catholics must go to Confession a minimum of once a year.

A reminder of a beautiful devotion during Fridays in Lent of the Stations of the Cross at 6:00 p.m. in the church. This is followed by a meatless soup supper in Foeller Hall. On March 15th, the Knights of Columbus will hold a Fish Fry in Foeller Hall from 5:00-7:00 p.m.

I hope these many activities during Lent will be beneficial to you.
