FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

As we begin the holiest week of the year, I wish to draw your attention to the schedule of liturgies and other activities this week.

On Monday, April 11, our parish will take part in the "Confession Monday" project of the Diocese of Columbus. Extra confession times are scheduled in every parish this day. Here at Sacred Hearts in Cardington, confessions will be heard at 7:00 p.m. At St. Mary's in Marion, confessions will be heard from 4:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m., and again at 7:00 p.m. This will be the last scheduled confession time before Easter.

On Tuesday, April 12, there will be no evening Mass, because the priests will travel to the Cathedral in Columbus for the annual Chrism Mass, during which the holy oils will be blessed for use during the next twelve months, and the priests present will renew their priestly promises of service.

On Wednesday, April 13, Mass is at 8:45 a.m. as usual.

Thursday, April 14 is Holy Thursday. There will be no morning Mass. We will celebrate the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 p.m. At the conclusion of the Mass, there will be the traditional Eucharistic Procession followed by adoration in silence until 10:00 p.m.

Friday, April 15 is Good Friday of the Lord's Passion. There is no morning Mass. The solemn liturgy of the Passion will take place at 3:00 p.m., including the chanting of the passion Gospel and the adoration of the Cross.

Saturday, April 16 is Holy Saturday. On this day, no Masses may be said, and the only sacraments celebrated are Confession and the Eucharist received as viaticum (i.e. by the dying). The great Easter Vigil begins at 8:30 p.m. with the blessing of the new fire.

On Easter Sunday, Mass will be at 9:00 a.m. as usual.

For the past two years, the Real Presence Diocese of Columbus has been working on a strategic planning initiative called Real Presence,



These are a first attempt at defining how parishes might be cared for by the clergy, which parishes are clustered together, how many priests are at each parish, etc. You are invited and strongly encouraged to provide feedback on the draft model for our parish. To do so, please go to https://realpresencerealfuture.org/ draft-models-spring-2022/ and view the video containing the draft models for planning area 3-North. You may provide your reflections and reactions in the Feedback Form by clicking the link next to the video. The deadline for feedback is June 30. Your input is critical in order for the planning committee to assess the viability of the draft model and, if necessary, to determine a more reasonable alternative.
