FROM THE PASTOR

During the past week, I met with the Parish Finance Council for our usual quarterly meeting. We welcomed the president and vice president of the HOST Guild (our parish women's club) who presented their budget for the upcoming fiscal year. Because the HOST Guild is a parish auxiliary organization, all funds in the HOST Guild bank account of parish funds and diocesan financial policy requires the pastor to review the financial activity of auxiliary groups. It was clear that the Guild has been very good stewards of funds that area raised on behalf of parish activities, and has very good plans for the upcoming fiscal year. The Finance Council also reviewed procedures for what to do when Fr. Shikina takes over as the new pastor on July 11, to ensure a smooth transition.

Next weekend, our parish will welcome a priest from the Spiritan Fathers who is taking part in the annual Missionary Cooperative Appeal in the Diocese of Columbus. The following weekend, we will have materials available for The Appeal (formerly the Bishop's Annual Appeal). Registered parishioners have received, or will soon receive, a mailing directly from Bishop Fernandes about The Appeal.
