# FROM THE PASTOR

# Christ is Risen! Indeed, He is risen!

This is the traditional Easter greeting of one believer to another. Something in this custom suggests a secret shared, and in fact Christians do share the one great secret: that love is stronger than death. This news is too good to be kept secret; that is why the Apostles, after the Resurrection of Christ, went out into the whole world to proclaim it. Sometimes people who know a wonderful secret will smile or laugh for no apparent reason. Others look at them and wonder why they are smiling. Do others look at us and sense our inner joy? Do we want to share the Good News with the whole world?

In the Baroque era, in parts of Germany, priests were required to insert a joke into their Easter homily, to make everyone laugh after the long and mirthless season of Lent. Laughter is an apt symbol of Easter joy. The Irish poet, Patrick Kavanaugh, wrote that after Christ rose from the dead,

"Men were afraid with a new fear, the fear of love. There was a laugh freed forever and for ever."

My Easter prayer for all of you is that you may laugh, rejoice, and be glad in the Lord. This is the Day the Lord has made: let us rejoice and be glad in it.
