I'm writing this column on Wednesday, May 18th, while seated in the beautiful conference center at Marytown, in Libertyville, Illinois. If that name sounds familiar to you, it is probably because the exhibit on the shroud of Turin that visited our parish during Lent came from the same place. Marytown is the national shrine of St. Maximilian Mary Kolbe, and is staffed by Franciscan friars. The beautiful shrine church is open for Adoration 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

I'm here to present a paper at the 72nd annual meeting of the Mariological Society of America. I will be delivering a more popular version of the same presentation this coming Wednesday at 7:00 p.m. in the basement of St. Mary Church in Marion, following the usual Wednesday evening Mass. The paper looks at what the New Testament says about the Virgin Mary and why.

Real Presence, Real Future – For the past two years, the Diocese of Columbus has been working on a strategic planning initiative called *Real Presence, Real Future* in an attempt to anticipate and meet the future needs of the diocese in view of changing demographics, declining church attendance, and an ongoing shortage of priests. At this stage, a set of proposals called draft models have been publicized. These are a first attempt at defining how parishes might be cared for by the clergy: which parishes are clustered together, how many priests are at each parish, etc. You are invited and strongly encouraged to provide feedback on the draft model for our parish. 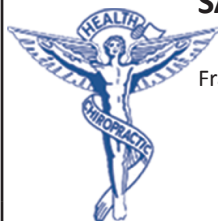

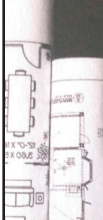
