FROM THE PASTOR

Christ is risen! He is truly risen, Alleluia! The Annual Appeal has begun (formerly the Bishop's Annual Appeal). You may have already received your envelope in the mail. If not, we will have extra brochures and envelopes in the church, beginning this weekend. The Appeal helps our Diocese to contribute to social concerns across the 23 counties of the Diocese of Columbus. It helps with Catholic education and with evangelization efforts in the Diocese. But the one thing everyone will notice is that it helps to fund the formation of new priests. We need the priests!

Almost one-third of what is collected through the Appeal will help pay for seminarians' tuition and room and board. That cost is \$55k per seminarian. This year, we had 16 new seminarians at an additional cost of almost \$1 million dollars. Without the ability to help them, they might not become priests. We had the special seminarian fund collection in late February and raised about \$500,000.00 across the Diocese. That was great, but we have more seminarians on the way. Good news indeed, but we need the priests and so we need to continue to help them to become priests. Please prayerfully consider contributing to the Appeal. It is an investment that will directly impact our spiritual lives. Our goal at Sacred Hearts is \$18,476.58. Even if you cannot give a large amount, I still ask for your participation, so even something like \$100 is helpful. Last year, we went over our goal, but we only had 25% participation. Of the roughly 200 registered families in the parish, imagine if the 150 families gave \$100.00. Anything over the goal will come back to the parish at 100%. Most likely all of that \$15,000 would come back to the parish and can be used for something exciting in our parish!

One exciting thing is stained-glass windows to help our church look even more beautiful! I am looking into this and will let you know as things develop. They are expensive, but I believe that we have enough families to pay for them if we have a high percentage of participation contributing to our parish.

On a separate but related note, if you do not currently contribute to the offertory, I ask, encourage, and invite you to contribute. The majority of our income comes from the offertory and one of the Church's precepts is to support your parish. You may contribute online or call Susan in the office about receiving envelopes.

Another way to contribute to the parish significantly is by creating or contributing to existing endowments. Similar to leaving money to the parish in a will, the endowment allows you to leave something to the parish, but it is managed and invested by The Catholic Foundation in Columbus. Your contribution only grows, so that what you give will be much greater in the end. You can either give now or give after you pass. We already have three endowments which benefit us greatly (Jane Ann Dean Endowment for the building maintenance, Sacred Hearts Endowment for general needs of the parish, and a Pipe Organ Endowment to cover repairs to the pipe organ) so I do thank those who have given to those endowments.
