The words of our Lord in today's Gospel should be part of our prayer as well, given the pressing need for more priests to labor in the Lord's vineyard: "The harvest is abundant but the laborers are few; so ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest".

During the past two weeks, Greg Goers from our Finance Council hosted two training sessions for the parish volunteers who count the collection on Sundays. We're grateful to these dedicated volunteers who work carefully to make sure that everyone's donation is correctly counted and that proper records are kept.

This Saturday morning, June 24, I will be in Ada giving a continuing education talk to permanent deacons of the Columbus Diocese before returning to Sacred Hearts for afternoon confessions and Mass.
