### FROM THE PASTOR

On Thursday, May 25, the Diocese of Columbus announced the decisions taken by Bishop Earl Fernandes at the conclusion of a three year process of study and consultation known as "Real Presence, Real Future". The process began as a way to understand what changes were needed in response to a smaller number of priests available to serve parishes, and a declining number of Catholics practicing the Faith (these numbers are, of course, interrelated). Recommendations were made to the Bishop, who accepted some and rejected others. When his final decisions were published, the bulletin for last weekend had already been sent in. So, by the time you read this, the Bishop's decisions might appear to be old news. That is not the case, however, as his decisions will affect this parish and many others for years to come.

As you may have read, the Bishop accepted the recommendation that St. Mary, Marion, and Sacred Hearts, Cardington, should undergo a canonical merger. This means they will ultimately become one single parish, with two church buildings in two different counties. One priest will serve as pastor of the new parish while the two churches retain their names. Ultimately, there will be one Finance Council and one Parish Pastoral Council.

I'm sure everyone wants to know when this will take place. The good news is that it will not happen right away. This will take time. Fr. Shikina will work with parishioners and diocesan support staff to develop a plan to be submitted to the Bishop for his approval. Thus, in the short term, you will not see any obvious differences in the life of your parish community. There will be no immediate changes to the schedule of Masses and confessions. Fr. Shikina will take over as Pastor on July 11 as planned, and Fr. Keller will continue to assist at both churches. St. Mary School and St. Mary Cemetery will continue to function just as they do now. The various parish groups and other Catholic organizations in Morrow and Marion counties will continue to meet.

I'd like to ask everyone to be patient, not to worry or spread rumors and, above all, pray for everyone who will be involved in bringing this process to a satisfactory conclusion that will benefit the growth and peace of Christ's holy church.
