FROM THE PASTOR

I'd like to offer my warmest thanks to everyone who helped with the farewell receptions held for me last weekend. I've received many messages of appreciation and good wishes during the past several days, and it is both heart-warming and heartbreaking. Years ago, I became acquainted with a Catholic priest who, before becoming a Roman Catholic, had been a clergyman in a Protestant denomination. He told me that one of the best things about the Catholic priesthood, as compared to the community he came from, was that in the Catholic Church, someone else tells you what your mission is. Over the years, I have come to see the wisdom in that observation.

This Tuesday is Independence Day, and due to the holiday, we are changing the daily Mass time on that day only. Mass will be celebrated at 8:45 a.m. There will be no 6:00 p.m. Mass that day. In this way, we will have the opportunity to begin the day with prayers for our country. In traditional Catholic piety, the month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood of Christ. The liturgical scholar Pius Parsch wrote: "The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary and reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it is the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us and through it washes and beautifies our soul and inaugurates the beginning of eternal life in it."
