#### FROM THE PASTOR

This week, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of Mary on Tuesday, August 15th. It is a Holy Day of Obligation, so those who can should attend Mass. We have one vigil Mass in Spanish on Monday evening at 7:00 p.m., and the other Masses will be on the day itself, Tuesday, at 8:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. at St Mary's and 8:45 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. at Sacred Hearts.

At St Mary's, the carpeting will be removed from the church floor beginning Wednesday, August 16th and the hardwood floor refinished. The estimated date of completion will be August 25th. This project was initiated and scheduled by Fr. Buffer before I arrived, so please note that I am not coming in and making massive changes in my first month here! Because of the floor work, the large organ in the choir loft will be sealed up and the smaller one removed beforehand so as to protect them from damage. Thus, there will be no accompanying instruments for the Masses on August 15th and for the weekends of August 19/20 and 26/27. The flooring company has assured us that we can still have Masses in the church on those two weekends. There will be no daily Masses at St. Mary's from August 16-25th. On Friday, August 18th, there will be no Holy Hour that afternoon, but we will still have confessions down below in Moira Hall from 5-6 p.m.

In this weekend's readings, the prophet Elijah encounters God on a mountain, in a cave, away from the noise of the world. He hears God not in loud thunder and earthquakes, but in a tiny, whispering sound. Likewise, Jesus himself needs to pray and he goes up on a mountain away from everyone else. We too need to pray and we too need the quiet and solitude to hear God's voice. Good is a quiet place in our home, but even better is the mountaintop in the church before the Blessed Sacrament in the tabernacle. Thanks be to God for the Eucharist that He has given us!


