FROM THE PASTOR

As I write this, it has been 3 weeks since I arrived at the two parishes. I’ve met a lot of people, and while I can hardly remember anyone’s name, or not yet match names with faces, it has been a grace of God that I do not feel overwhelmed. It is also due to your welcome and friendliness. You’ve made it easy for me to enjoy being at the parishes. I also want to thank the staff and volunteers who work hard for the parishes. I can tell already that due to your passion, generosity, and work ethic, the parishes are humming along. It is all of you, staff and parishioners alike who make the parishes great! In the recent weekday Mass readings, Moses encounters the presence of God to converse with Him both on Mt. Sinai and in a meeting tent. The meeting tent itself is the origin of the word “tabernacle” which we use today to house the Blessed Sacrament. The story of Moses depicts the Lord manifesting Himself in a particular physical place. This Sunday on the Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord, Jesus manifests his divinity to Peter, James, and John when he takes them up on a high mountain. Again, it is a physical place in which the Lord’s divine presence is manifested.

While God can hear our prayers everywhere, we are blessed to have physical spaces in which we can enter into the presence of God. We can go to our tabernacle in our churches and converse with Him in His Real Presence in the Blessed Sacrament. Moses could have encountered the Lord anywhere, but the Lord instructed him to go to those specific places to converse with Him. Moses would then leave those spaces with his face so radiant from his encounter with the Lord that he would have to veil his face so the people could look at him. I encourage everyone to make it a habit to take time to go to the churches and sit before the tabernacles to converse with the Lord. They are physical places and the effects upon you will not only be spiritual, but physical. You will radiate with God’s grace and other people will notice it. At St Mary’s in Marion, the church is usually open throughout the day. At Sacred Hearts in Cardington, there is a small chapel on the back side of the church. You would need a code to get inside outside of business hours (the church itself is open during business hours). Please call the office to get the code and you are welcome to pray in that chapel at any time, day or night.
