The pancake breakfast is being reviewed until September. The number of breakfasts served has been down to around 30. Since we show up around 6:00 a.m. to get the breakfast items ready to be served at 7:00 a.m. and serve until 10:00 a.m. and then clean up the kitchen and lock up after 11:00 a.m... Well, maybe you see where this is going. The 12 different charities that we have donated to for the last several years may no longer be able to depend on Sacred Hearts Knights of Columbus council for a check. My brother Knights and I will be sad to stop the pancake breakfasts if our number served doesn't get back to over 40 each month. The checks we had been able to give to these groups was usually around \$200.00 or more when breakfasts exceeded 40. I am hopeful that our numbers will pick up quickly so we will see that the fruits of our labor is worth the effort being produced by the Knights of Columbus.

Our meetings will remain the same – the 1st and 4th Wednesdays of each month at 7:00 p.m. Catholic men age 18 and over can be Knights of Columbus. They announced at the meeting that the Columbus Diocese's Vocation director, Father William Hahn, was presented a check in the amount of **\$68,000.00 for the seminarians, which was the LARGEST amount of all 6 Ohio dioceses!** We need more men in the seminarian program to become priests. I hope all who read this get excited and start to donate, and those who already do feel the thrill of helping such a worthwhile needed cause!

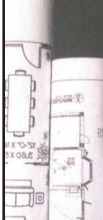
