The pancake breakfast is being reviewed. The number of breakfasts we serve is down to less than 30. We show up at 6 am to start cooking and leave around 11 am by the time everything is cleaned up. Spending five hours to serve 30 people is not ideal. We need to get our numbers back up to 40+. We have 12 charities that we donate our monthly profit of usually \$200, but only serving 30 meals, this gives them much less. When our numbers are up, they receive a larger donation. We have been doing our pancake breakfast for over 10 years and I'm sure these charities have come to rely on our yearly donation. If we decide to continue this breakfast, please consider attending on the second Saturday of the month so we can continue giving donations to 12 charities in Morrow County. More information will be coming soon.

Thank you to everyone that donates to support our seminarians. Last year we donated \$2,000 From April through August of this year, we have collected \$619. We will continue to collect money after each weekend mass. There is also a container in the Narthex for your donations during other times. The Columbus Diocese received \$68,000 for the seminarians in May. This was the largest donation from all six dioceses in Ohio.

As of July 1st, a new fraternal year has begun. We have some new members as well as some new officers for the year. Our business meeting is on the 1st Wednesday of the month with our social meeting on the 4th Wednesday. Both start at 7 pm. Catholic men aged 18 and over can be a Knight of Columbus.
