FROM THE PASTOR

Greetings in the Lord Jesus Christ! As I write this, it is the Memorial of the Passion of Saint John the Baptist. In the reading from Mark 6:17-29, we hear that King Herod had married his brother's wife, Herodias. John the Baptist said to him, "It is not lawful for you to have your brother's wife." For this reason, Herodias harbored a grudge against him and demanded his head upon a platter. John the Baptist was then beheaded, not specifically for preaching about Jesus, but rather for speaking the truth about marriage. Because Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life, when we speak the truth, we proclaim Jesus, even if we do not mention His name specifically, for He is Truth itself. In this weekend's first reading, the prophet Jeremiah can't help but speak the truth as he says, "All the day I am an object of laughter; everyone mocks me. I say to myself, I will not mention him, I will speak in his name no more. But then it becomes like fire burning in my heart, imprisoned in my bones; I grow weary holding it in, I cannot endure it." We should speak the truth with charity and with prudence. Sometimes it is hard to know when to speak and when not to speak, but we should not fear for ourselves when a truth must be spoken. The Lord assures us, "They will fight against you, but not prevail over you, for I am with you to deliver you, says the LORD" (Jeremiah 1:19).


