FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Friends in Christ,

This week's bulletin includes a summary financial report for the parish, based on the complete financial report reviewed by the parish finance council. You will see that our financial position is currently very sound. At its most recent meeting, finance council noted that the balance in the checking account has increased by \$39,227 in just twelve months, and recommended that some of the money accumulated in that account be moved into reserves and endowments. Accordingly, \$20,000 will be transferred to our PAF account (parish reserves or savings), \$20,000 to the Cardington Endowment at the Catholic Foundation, proceeds from which are used for general parish expenses, and \$10,000 to the Jane Ann Dean Endowment at the Catholic Foundation, which supports the maintenance and repair of parish buildings. If you have more detailed questions about the finance report, please speak with any member of the finance council or with me.

The pancake breakfast is currently being reviewed. The number of breakfasts served has been down to less than 30. We arrive at 6:00 a.m. to start cooking and stay until everything is cleaned up, usually around 11:00 a.m. Spending five hours to serve 30 people is not ideal. We need to get our numbers back up over 40. We have 12 charities who receive our monthly profit. It was usually \$200.00, but only serving 30 meals gives them much less. When our numbers are up, they receive a larger donation. We have been doing our pancake breakfast for over 10 years, and I'm sure these charities have come to rely on our yearly donation. If we decide to continue this breakfast, please consider attending on the second Saturday of the month so we can continue giving donations to 12 charities in Morrow County. More information will be coming soon.

Thank you to everyone who donated to support our seminarians. Last year we donated \$2,000.00. From April through August of this year, we have collected \$619.00. We will continue to collect money after each weekend Mass. There is also a container in the Narthex for your donations during other times. The Columbus Diocese received \$68,000 for the seminarians in May. This was the largest donation from all six dioceses in Ohio.

As of July 1st, a new fraternal year has begun. We have some new members as well as some new officers for the year. Our business meeting is on the 1st Wednesday of the month with our social meeting on the 4th Wednesday. Both start at 7:00 p.m. Catholic men age 18 and over can be Knights of Columbus. Currently, your first year of dues are free. Just ask us how.

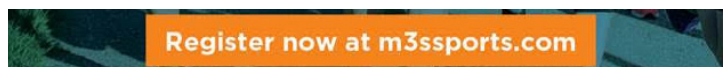

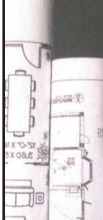
